VINTAGE LOCOMOTIVE PEDESTAL AND SELFIE POINT IN CIRCULATING AREA

With a view to revisit the heritage past of the Railways in the city, a vintage locomotive has been placed on pedestal in the circulating area & a Selfie Point to uphold the dynamic nature of the city. The Diesel Locomotive Workshop,

Bardhaman & commissioned on 28th Sept, 1992 at Diesel Shed Bardhaman. The loco was retired on 5th January 2015 after 24 years of excellent service in Western Railway. This selfie point will be an added attraction to the bustling city & will enable the public as well as railway passengers to find moments of cheer and pride. This duo combination has uplifted the face of circulating area.

INTEGRATED SECURITY SYSTEM (CCTV CONTROL ROOM AND SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS)

Taking into cognizance the amount of passenger footfall at Surat station and to enhance the safety and security of passengers, a new Integrated Security Control Room with modern amenities was a must at Surat station. To fulfill this requirement, High-tech cameras were planned to be installed throughout station premises to cover all areas of the station 24x7. The work was undertaken on a war footing at a cost of Rs. 1.22 crores and has been completed. 86 cameras will be covering the entire Surat station, with 68 cameras having already been installed and functional and the rest will be connected very soon. 3 types of High-Quality cameras i.e., PTZ (Pan-Tilt-Zoom); 4K cameras (Very High-Quality images for Face Recognition) and FHD (Full

Darbhanga priest gunned down inside Kankali temple; public lynch 1 suspect



DARBHANGA: Four armed men shot dead Darbhanga's Kankali temple priest, Rajiv Kumar Jha, early on Thursday morning, police said. Three of them were caught by local people and thrashed. One of them died later, people aware of the matter said. One person, Shambhu Choudhary, who sustained injuries when he tried to intervene, was in the initial shooting, has been admitted to a local hospital and is said to be out of danger.

According to people who were out on a morning walk, four suspects drove down to the temple located in the Darbhanga Raj Fort complex, popularly known as Ram Bagh campus, in a blue car, and walked right in.

It was 4am, and the priest was inside. Rajiv Kumar Jha spent the night at the temple because the puja for the Navratri festivities had continued well past midnight. Witnesses outside heard multiple gunshots. Rajiv Kumar Jha, the priest said to be in his late forties, was their target, a police officer said. Passers-by and devotees

reacted immediately and caught hold of three of them; the fourth escaped.

The young man who died in the mob lynching was identified by the police as Pulkrit Singh, son of a clerk at the LN Mishra University. The other two are being treated at Darbhanga Medical College and Hospital. Darbhanga senior superintendent of police Babu Ram said a special team has been set up to call out the probe and track down the fourth man involved in the shooting. 'The assailants were not career criminals, contract killers or involved in robberies,' he said.

The SSP said the shooting appeared to be linked to an altercation on Wednesday night. Two of the four suspects were sitting by the pond near the temple. Due to some reason, the two had an altercation with the priest, his family and some others. 'The two left the complex but were back six hours later with two more accomplices when they allegedly gunned down the priest. A pistol and six spent cartridges have been seized from the spot.'

JAIPUR: A luxury car being driven by a 17-year-old allegedly rammed a hand cart and a two-wheeler in Rajasthan's Jodhpur late on Thursday evening, killing a 30-year-old man and injuring two others, police said.

The teenager, a Jodhpur police inspector's son, was in the car with two others including a minor. The third person in the vehicle was a 23-year-old. They are college students, a local police officer said. The dead man was identified as Sadekat Ali, 30, said Likhma Ram, Chaupasani station house officer (SHO). Gujarat receives 102% rainfall of annual average

AHMEDABAD: The southwest monsoon withdrew from the remaining parts of Gujarat on Tuesday, marking the end of the monsoon season for the state. Compared to the normal withdrawal date of September 30, overall withdrawal was extended by nearly a fortnight this year, said India Meteorological Department (IMD) officials.

The withdrawal line of the southwest monsoon now passes through Aurangabad and Silvassa; the IMD bulletin said. Manorama Mohanty, head of the IMD for the Gujarat region, said this year the state received 703.4mm of rainfall against its long-term average of 692.4mm. "Thus, the state has received 102% of its seasonal rainfall. Region-wise, there is a disparity - Saurashtra and Kutch got 24% excess rain, while the rest of Gujarat was 12% deficient," she said.

District-wise analysis reveals that 20 of the state's 33 districts received normal rainfall or higher, while 13 districts, primarily in north and central Gujarat, remained slightly deficient. However, the overall deficit reduced considerably due to the excess rain in September, IMD officials said.

Four held with MD worth Rs 11.7 lakh

Ahmedabad : Four persons were arrested for drug trafficking after 11.57 gms of mephedrone, a popular party drug, was seized from them in Titoda village near Deesa on Monday.

Deputy superintendent of police, Deesa, Kausal Oza said the seized narcotic is valued at around Rs 11.75 lakh. The four were coming in a car from Rajasthan when police team of inspector MJ Chaudhary asked them to stop for checking near Kansari.

When a car stopped Chudhary and team checked it thoroughly and police recovered the contraband. The arrested persons were identified Banwarlal Jat, Ratanlal Nai, Hanumanjat and Hanuman Retinal, all from Rajasthan.
